



What is Pro Gigger?

Pro Gigger is a piece of software to emulate the functions of the minidisk player that a performer uses on stage. You program your set list from the available tracks, with one slight difference - You can save these for later recall. Pro Gigger also connects to the USB interface supplied so that you can use a foot switch to start and pause your tracks.

What music formats does it play?

Pro Gigger plays the following - MP3, WAV and WMA formats.

How much does it cost?

Pro Gigger costs £60 + Postage, a small price to pay for a more professional show.

Pentium PC or equivalent
Windows XP
Dot Net Framework V2

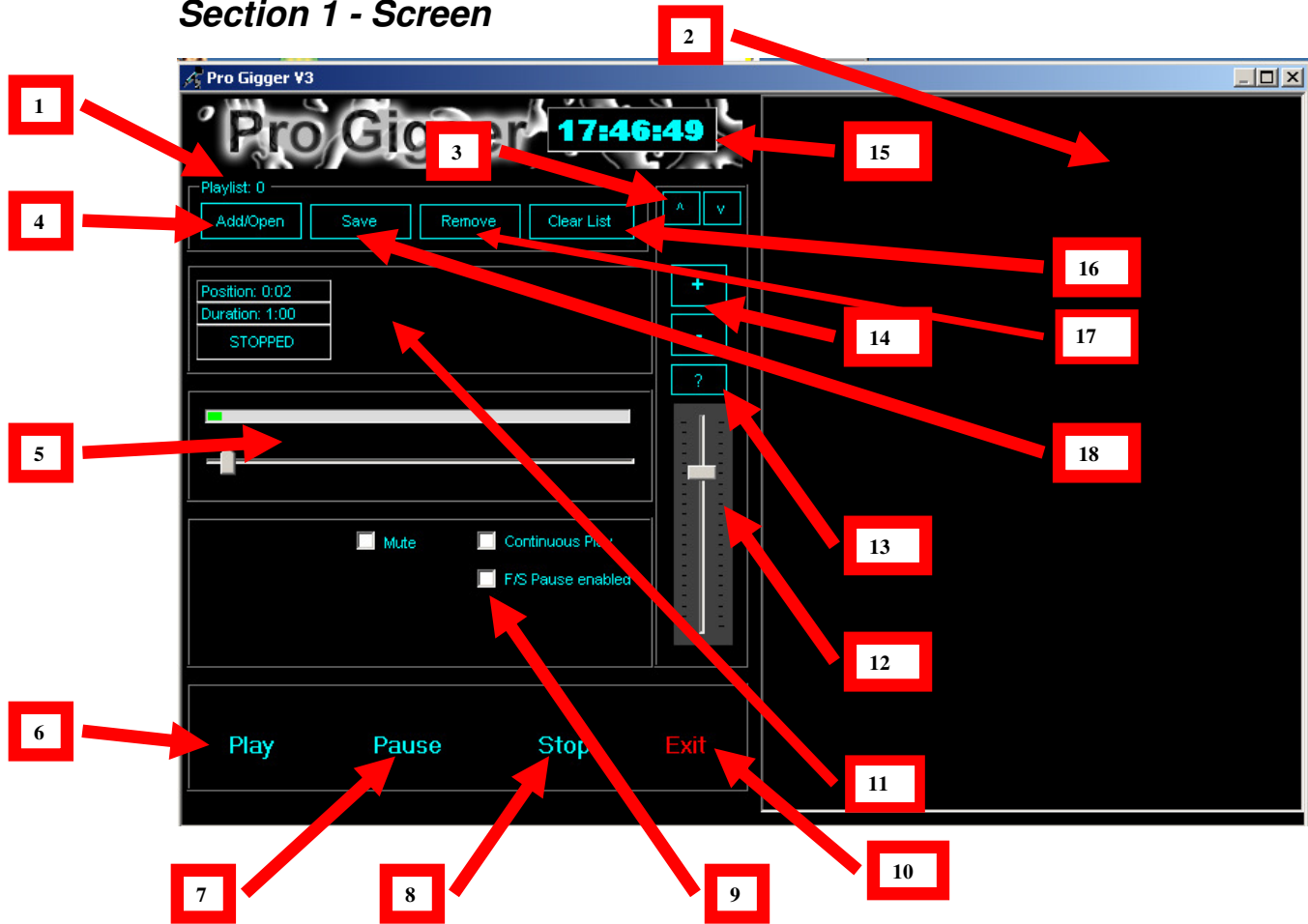

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Pro Gigger

Section 1 - Screen



1. Playlist – Displays number of files in playlist
2. Filenames – Displays files queued to play
3. Move Buttons – Allows highlighted file to be moved up and down in the playlist
4. Add/Open Button – Allows files/saved playlists to be added to the playlist
5. Position marker & Position mover – Shows position of file being played and allows for position in file to be changed
6. Play button – Plays the highlighted file in the playlist
7. Pause button – pauses the current file and allows resume
8. Stop button – Stops the current file being played
9. Option checkboxes – allows certain option to be selected
10. Exit Button – Exits the application Immediately
11. Position, Duration Current activity and countdown timer.
12. Volume control – Allows change of volume
13. About button – shows details about the application
14. Playlist font enlarge and reduce
15. Time – Displays current time of the computer
16. Clear button – clears the whole playlist
17. Remove button – removes the selected file from the playlist
18. Save button – allows save of the current playlist for later recall

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Section 2 - Quick start guide

Installation

1. Install Dotnet V2 Framework runtime files if they are not already installed on your computer (Available from www.Microsoft.com)
2. Install Pro Gigger from the setup file available from www.progigger.co.uk

The setup process will install Pro Gigger onto your computer and create a shortcut on your desktop as well as a start menu shortcut.

Running

1. Double click on the Pro Gigger icon on you desktop, Pro Gigger will start as a time limited trial until fully registered.
2. Click on the continue button to access the main screen of Pro Gigger.
3. Click the Add/Open Button to add files to your playlist. (I suggest that all your files are stored in a directory on the ROOT of your drive e.g. C:\TRACKS and name them something easily recognizable.)
4. Double click on a file to add it to the playlist.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to add more files to the playlist.
6. Press the SPACE BAR to emulate the footswitch when you are ready to play your files or click on the play button. The first file will play and cue the next track ready.

Option buttons

There are three option buttons on the main screen as follows: -

1. Mute - Completely mutes the output from the computer
2. Continuous Play – When checked Auto Pause is disabled and the files in the playlist will play sequentially without intervention from the user. When unchecked Auto Pause is enabled and Play will stop at the end of the file.
3. FS Pause Enabled – When checked allows you to pause and resume the track from the footswitch.

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
